Mineral cases show their weakness in lack of structure or capability, and express a need for structure so as to perform well. The periodic table is a sequence and each element reveals a pattern relating to its position in the row + column of the periodic table. Penny Edwards will explain the themes of each stage of the periodic table using cases that describe sensations expressed from the source of the substance. Explaining the kingdoms methodology she will highlight the language of mineral cases, themes of each row of the periodic table, and differentiate what the elements in, for instance, column 3, or 10, 11,12 of any row have in common with other remedies in corresponding positions in the table. Cases of patients who presented with anxiety with palpitations, structural joint problems, allergies, breathing difficulties, a brain tumour, and a case of an IT consultant who oiled the cogs of an organisation.

Penny Edwards is an experienced classical homeopath who has taught homeopathy worldwide in Japan, Croatia and New Zealand and has brought leading proponents of Sensation homeopathy to teach in the UK as part of her work with Pinnacle Seminars.
