Following the suggestions of a good number of homeopaths from the North-West we have decided this year to have a seminar on cancer.

Few of us have the opportunity to treat a patient with cancer exclusively with Homeopathy. However, we are often asked what Homeopathy can do for a patient who has cancer and is preparing to undergo allopathic treatment for it, be it chemotherapy, radiotherapy, surgery and/or hormone treatment. There is a lack of awareness on the part of the public and the medical profession as to what a valuable tool Homeopathy can be for the mental and physical suffering of this group of people.

As homeopaths we know treatment can be constitutional, organ-based, antimiasmatic, isopathic, symptom based, with or without some anthroposophic medicines, or a combination of all the above.

The purist, classical Homeopath will naturally think of constitutional treatment; this is an ideal approach that may be seen in places with poor or limited access to the treatments of modern medicine, such as parts of India, where Homeopathy has been the first line of treatment, with encouraging results.

Globally, allopathic medicine remains the dominant mode of treatment for cancer patients. However, we do know that Homeopathy can do a lot for these patients. Clinics in India and Europe have provided evidence of this and many homeopaths from all over the world have successful cases to share. How can we leave such a good therapeutic medium go to waste when there is so much need for it? and, crucially, when we see more and more clinical evidence of its efficacy and with such good return for little cost.

Dr Bagot and his colleagues have been doing excellent work in this area within a National Health system in France for over ten years now. His very practical advice from this experience has been recorded in his book *Cancer and Homeopathy: How to alleviate the side effects of chemotherapy, radiation, surgery and hormone therapy* (2014). This book should be read by every homeopath and every professional in the field of cancer, as well patients and their families.

This seminar will encourage us to learn more and gain the confidence to undertake the treatment of these patients ourselves, and hopefully even inspire us to initiate programmes in collaboration with cancer therapy institutions.

Whether you are a purist Classical Homeopath or not, there will be a lot of useful information to take from this seminar and an opportunity to ask an expert in this field your own questions.

This seminar is open to homeopaths of all levels, medical or not, nurses, oncologists, doctors, anyone with an interest in this subject.



Dr. Jean-Lionel Bagot is a graduate in Oncology and General Practice and a homeopathic doctor in Strasbourg. He specialises in Integrative Supportive Care in Oncology.

A pioneer in this field in Europe, in 2006 he founded the first homeopathic clinic of supportive care in Saint Vincent Hospital Group, Strasbourg. In 2016, he founded -and still manages- the International Homeopathic Society for Supportive Care in Oncology (IHSSCO) www.shisso-infos.com, which has approximately one hundred members in seven different countries.

Dr. Bagot is the current President of the National Federation of French Homeopathic Medical Societies (FNSMHF) that brings together all French homeopaths. He is a Lecturer at the Faculty of Medicine and Pharmacy in Strasbourg, an internship supervisor at Strasbourg University and responsible for the university degree in homeopathy in Strasbourg.

Dr. Bagot is the author of the practical guide: "Cancer and Homeopathy, How to alleviate the side effects of chemotherapy, radiation, surgery and hormone treatment". He has spoken in over a hundred congresses and seminars internationally and is the author of numerous publications.
